Scope of the Position

The Assistant Manager, Global Communications is responsible for assisting with the management of all of Habib's global relationships and communications initiatives, the creation and timely dissemination of Habib University's global communications materials and facilitating all global happenings on the Habib campus. The position is expected to take intellectual ownership of all of Habib University's global communication initiatives. Additionally, the Assistant Manager, Global Communications will also be responsible for instituting the 'Friends of Habib' program.

This position reports to the Manager for Global Engagement and works in frequent consultation with the Office of Public Affairs and the Office of the President.

Summary of Key Functions

Specific Roles and Responsibilities:

1. Develop procedures and guidelines for internal requests for international collaborations, while evaluating lateral coordination for Habib University's strategic goals in global partnerships

2. Create and maintain a comprehensive database for managing contacts in Habib's global network including but not limited to donors, scholars and members of the diaspora

3. Organize and execute on-campus tours for global stakeholders, events, conferences, keynote lectures, and relevant workshops or seminars

4. Conceptualize, create content for, oversee the design and timely dissemination of Habib University's bi-annual

publication, Hum Khayal (Partners in Thought) and quarterly newsletter, Hum Qadam (Partners in Action)

5. Create tailored updates for different groups of stakeholders in the 'Friends of Habib' network

6. Identify and develop other methods and mechanisms for boosting Habib University's global profile and reach

7. Curate and promote Habib University's vibrant global presence on social media platforms and a dedicated blog

8. Investigate partnership and relationship-building opportunities to support existing and new programs

9. Assist with any OGE related or other on-campus events as needed

10. Execute other tasks as requested or determined by the Manager of the Office for Global Engagement and the Office of the President
