Scope of the Position

- Coordinating with mechanical, electrical and IT team for design execution.
- Acquiring materials e.g. fittings, furniture, lighting, finishes, decoration & dressing, and arranging samples for clients according to set budgets.
- Supervising the execution of plan on campus.
- In addition, an interior designer may also sometimes act as a project manager for the client throughout the planning & construction stage.
