POSITION DESCRIPTION

Habib University will offer a month long summer prep program to the applicants of HU TOPS. HU TOPS applicants belong to the Board of Intermediate Examination, Federal Board and Aga Khan University Examination Board and are currently studying in Intermediate Part II. The Mathematics instructor for the HU TOPS Summer Prep Program will be responsible for developing a month long program to prepare students for the Advanced Mathematics test for admission into the School of Science and Engineering. The Advanced Mathematics test focuses on HSSC and SSC (Intermediate and Matriculation level) mathematics topics. The instructor will also be responsible for conducting the classes as well as assessing student performance on an on-going basis.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

• Developing the Content/plan for HU Summer Prep Program

- Developing the overall content/plan to be taught to the students, focusing on HSSC and SSC mathematics concepts.
- o The instructor must especially focus on the following topics:
 - Algebraic Operations
 - Solutions of Equations and Inequalities
 - Functions
 - Trigonometry
 - Coordinate Geometry
 - Applications and other Algebra topics
- The plan will also have the content to equip students with test taking skills and various forms of questions. The plan will be in writing and shared with the Office of Admissions prior to the commencement of the Program by end May 2017
- o Preparing in class and homework assignments
- Selecting the reading material for the students

• Conducting the Classes

- o Conducting the classes of enrolled students in June
- o Ensuring active student engagement throughout the program
- Developing alternative tools to bolster student skill set

• Assessing the Students

- Designing assessment tasks to assess students' performance on an on-going basis
- o Grading the formal assignments
- o Providing feedback about each student to the Office of Admissions
