Habib University's Learn Abroad Program is an outcome of our partnerships with Stanford University; the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor; the University of California, Berkeley; and Pitzer College. The Program aims to help enterprising students enrich and diversify their undergraduate learning experience and build leadership skills in an increasingly globalized world by spending a few weeks, months, or an entire semester at a world-renowned university.

With security and socio-political challenges increasingly restricting Pakistani youth from experiencing an international education, HU's Learn Abroad Program facilitates students in supplementing their learning at HU with structured learning opportunities at international universities. Around 8-10% of HU students can avail these opportunities every year, and use them to shape their postgraduate education as well as their professional career.

The Program encompasses a wide range of objectives: primarily, it aims to help students enrich their undergraduate degree with a unique learning experience at a globally respected university; secondly, it also prepares them to compete internationally to gain admissions to – and scholarships for – some of the world's best graduate programs.

LEARN ABROAD: Stanford University

A highly selective, challenging eight-week academic and cultural program, the Stanford Summer International Honors Program (SSIHP) is an excellent opportunity for you to experience an immersive summer in a stimulating international environment at one of the world's leading universities.

SSIHP brings highly motivated students to the Stanford campus from over 20 partner institutions in 14 countries. Participants enroll in summer courses taught by Stanford faculty, learn with Stanford undergraduates and other visiting students, and participate in co-curricular programs designed specifically for them.

A member of The Claremont Colleges, Pitzer shares consortium resources (libraries, dining halls, etc.) and students are encouraged to take classes at the other four undergraduate Claremont Colleges as well. The college emphasizes social sciences, international programs, and media studies.

LEARN ABROAD: University of California, Berkeley

Under a new partnership, Habib University students will now be able to enrol in the Summer Sessions program at the University of California, Berkeley (UC Berkeley). UC Berkeley is often cited as the top public university in the United States and around the world.

The Summer Sessions at UC Berkeley offer an opportunity for students to take classes with UC Berkeley and other visiting domestic and international students. Students may choose from a wide range of courses (over 600), which are taught by regular Berkeley faculty.

The Summer Sessions offer multiple terms of differing lengths: for instance, students may choose to attend a six-week session, an eight-week session, or join for the entire ten-week term. Students have the option to reside on or off campus in the town of Berkeley, and will enjoy easy access to downtown San Francisco.

LEARN ABROAD: National University of Singapore

Habib University has partnered with Sajjad Foundation to select and sponsor students who aspire to attend the Summer Enterprise Program at National University of Singapore from all over Pakistan.

Conducted over two weeks, this residential program offers a unique opportunity for you to learn about how one of the smaller nations in the world has progressed from a trading port to a destination for international commerce and investment.

In a multi-cultural, cosmopolitan environment, you get to learn how public policies are formulated and gain important insights on business practices and entrepreneurship development in Singapore.

The Office of Global Engagement will provide you the counseling and guidance you need to select the right program for your needs; help you complete your applications; and also guide you in looking for different sources of funding you may require to attend the program of your choice.

THE FINE PRINT

The Learn Abroad programs can be availed by all Habib University students. However, to make sure that both the University and you make the best of these amazing opportunities, a high standard is maintained for selection.

- Most Learn Abroad programs are open to students who:
 - o Have a strong academic record and meet the minimum CGPA requirement for the Program;
 - o Have followed the Student Code of Conduct and have not been charged for any academic or conduct violation.
 - o Have participated in activities beyond the classroom, such as research, community service, co-curricular activities, peer tutoring, etc.
- Applications for Learn Abroad are assessed on the basis of:
 - o Academic achievement (GPA, plus any special commendations on project/coursework);
 - o Clarity of purpose;
 - o Demonstrated interest in cross-cultural interaction and gaining international experience;


- o Commitment to high academic achievement and interest in graduate school;
- o Metacurricular activities, awards and honors, hobbies, interests, etc. (including awards and honors received in high school);
- o Research skills and experience, if applicable;
- o Work experience, if applicable;
- o Critical thinking ability, effective communication ability;
- o Ability to take initiative and build linkages (leadership skills).
