[The Social Development and Policy Program](#), School of Arts Humanities and Social Sciences, Habib University invites applications from qualified candidates for Assistant/Associate/Full Professor (open rank) positions in the interdisciplinary area of Social Development and Policy, to commence in Spring and Fall, 2019. The position will be based in Karachi, Pakistan. The appointee will assume a combination of teaching, service and research responsibilities with an annual course load of five.

Applications are welcome from all social science disciplines. A PhD in Anthropology, Sociology, Economics, Political Sciences, Development Studies, Gender/Women's Studies, Education or a related discipline, as well as strong and collaborative administrative experience committed to interdisciplinary work within a liberal arts environment is required. Field experience in Social Development Policy as well as familiarity with the South Asian context will be considered as an asset.

The successful candidate will demonstrate excellence or the promise of excellence in teaching, scholarly research, publications, service at various levels. The successful candidates will be expected to take a leadership role in the development, review and delivery of the program.

Ability to teach in multiple areas of social development and policy would be deemed an added strength. Pedagogical innovation in high priority areas such as critical thinking and experiential education and technology enhanced learning would be an advantage.

Applicants should submit a letter of application outlining relevant experience, an up-to-date curriculum vitae, a sample of writing, examples of published research and a teaching dossier which supports excellence and innovation in teaching (including student teaching evaluations and a teaching statement) through our [online faculty application form](#).
