

Announcement of Film & Media Production Faculty Positions Communication & Design Program School of Arts, Humanities & Social Sciences

The <u>School of Arts and Social Sciences</u> (AHSS) at <u>Habib University</u> invites applications for open-rank faculty positions for Film & Media Production in its <u>Communication & Design</u> program. Depending on the credentials, candidates will be considered at Assistant Professor or Associate Professor ranks as appropriate.

The program seeks talented faculty who are passionate about teaching and student learning, and who are excited about the challenge of reimagining teaching Film & Media Production at the undergraduate level in line with global developments in the field. Habib University seeks outstanding student mentors who will be involved in the lives of students through mentoring, student support, enrolment initiatives, and other activities related to the undergraduate education experience.

Fall appointments begin August 1st and Spring appointments begin January 1st.

Qualification: Candidates with a minimum of an MFA degree, or equivalent terminal degree, and background in media production, cinematography, directing, screenwriting, post-production, and/or similar fields. Candidates with a multi-disciplinary arts background with relevant experience, as well as media theory and history will also be considered. Ideal candidates should be able to demonstrate creative productivity, develop the program, and advance the program's mission to integrate the study and production of media with the local community and context. Media educators with a teaching portfolio who can demonstrate an ability to teach a combination of practice-based studio classes and seminar courses; experience running communications, media, and/or film program; broad demonstrable knowledge of media history and theory and/or an active practice that demonstrates expertise in at least one of the following: cinematography, direction, post-production/editing, will be given preference.

Responsibilities: Primary responsibilities include: teaching undergraduate courses, active engagement in institutional service, professional activities, student mentorship, curriculum planning, and review. The annual teaching load is 5 three- or four-credit courses.
