

Announcement of User Experience or Interaction Design Faculty Positions Communication & Design Program School of Arts, Humanities & Social Sciences

The <u>School of Arts and Social Sciences</u> (AHSS) at <u>Habib University</u> invites applications for open-rank faculty positions for User Experience (UX) Design Interaction (IxD) in its <u>Communication & Design</u> program. Depending on the credentials, candidates will be considered at Assistant Professor or Associate Professor ranks as appropriate.

The program seeks talented faculty who are passionate about teaching and student learning, and who are excited about the challenge of reimagining the teaching of the User Experience (UX) Design Interaction (IxD) Design at the undergraduate level in line with global developments in the field. Habib University seeks outstanding student mentors who will be involved in the lives of students through mentoring, student support, enrolment initiatives, and other activities related to the undergraduate education experience.

Fall appointments begin August 1st and Spring appointments begin January 1st.

Qualification: Candidates must have a Ph.D. or terminal degree, and relevant background in interaction design, user experience design, human-computer interaction, or similar fields. Candidates with backgrounds in service design, systemic design, industrial design, or communication design, or related fields like architecture, may also be considered if they also have relevant professional or research experience. Ideal candidates should possess strong visual and/or tangible design skills and demonstrate a capacity for conducting original and creative work informed by critical research with stakeholders, an active professional or scholarly design practice, be able to consider the design of interactions, interfaces, and experiences beyond the screen, and/or have experience relevant to design practice and pedagogy in the Global South. Candidates applying with related teaching experience and a teaching portfolio, who can demonstrate an ability to teach a combination of practice-based studio classes and seminar courses on design research and practice will have preference.

Responsibilities: Primary responsibilities include: teaching undergraduate courses, active engagement in institutional service, professional activities, student mentorship, curriculum planning and review. The annual teaching load is 5 three- or four-credit courses.
