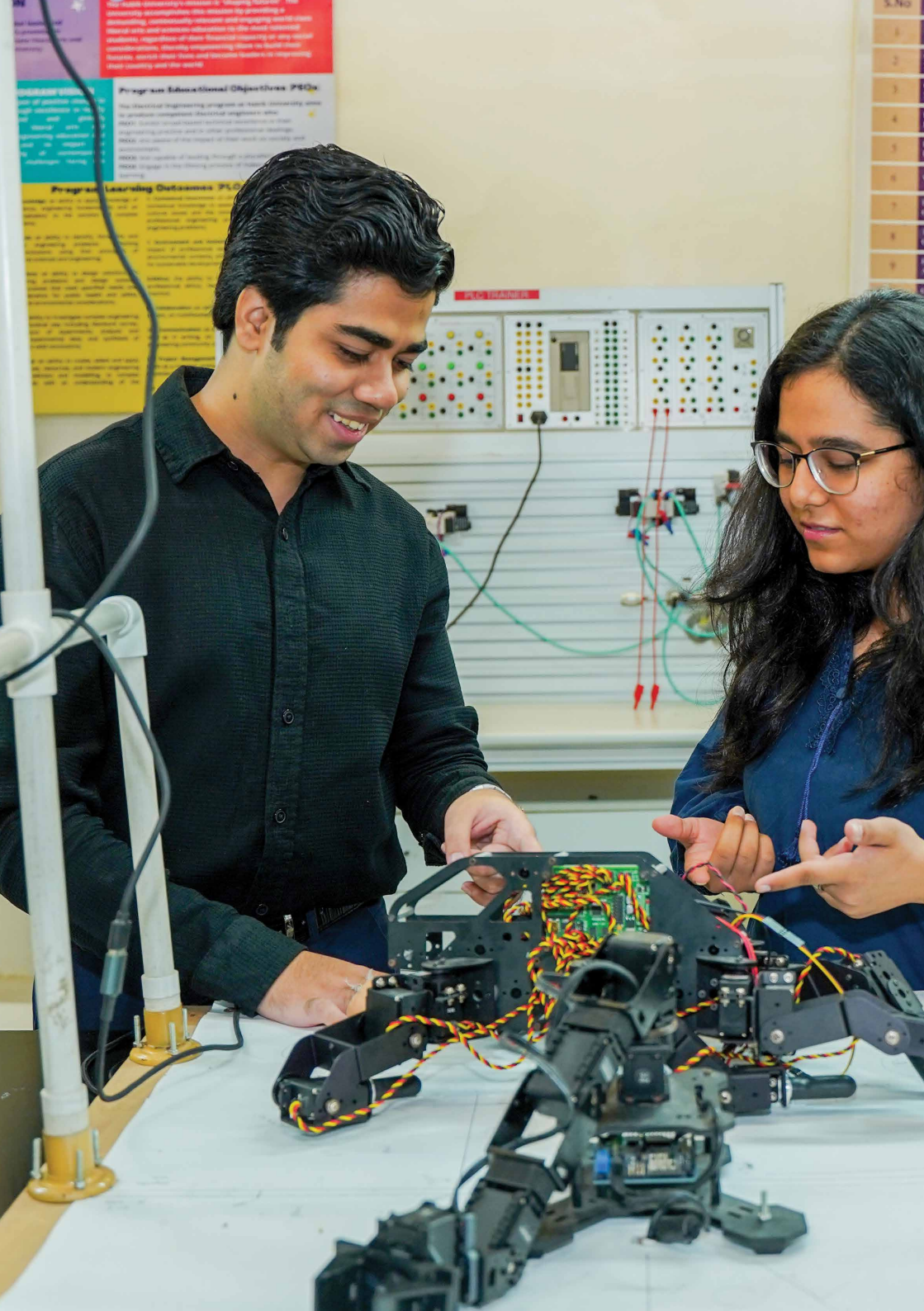
WELCOME TO THE BEGINNING OF A NEW JOURNEY!

LEARNING ENGAGEMENT AND ADVISING PROGRAM (LEAP) FOR HU TOPS STUDENTS

The Learning Engagement and Advising Program (LEAP) is designed to provide HU TOPS students with the support necessary for a successful transition into university life.

LEAP demonstrates Habib University's commitment to creating exceptional learning opportunities for its students. We care for our students and therefore, we want to offer you exciting platforms not only to understand the rich learning fabric of HU but also to start building relationships with the HU community and develop a sense of belonging to its space even before the commencement of your first semester.

LEAP will provide students a platform to explore and hone university level academic skills such as Critical Reading, Academic Writing, Active Listening, and Speaking. Computer Science and Engineering students will also be engaged in acquiring basic programming skills to get ready for their first Programming Fundamental Course in Semester 1. All Arts, Humanities and Social Science Students will be provided an opportunity to enhance their research skills.

The program will also help HU TOPS students to understand their selected degree programs and advise them to select and get enrolled in semester 1 courses by acquiring a working understanding of Habib University's technology tools such as PeopleSoft and CANVAS.

This year, LEAP will take place from 18th July to 7th August, 2024.

ENSURING YOUR PHYSICAL AND PSYCHOLOGICAL WELLBEING

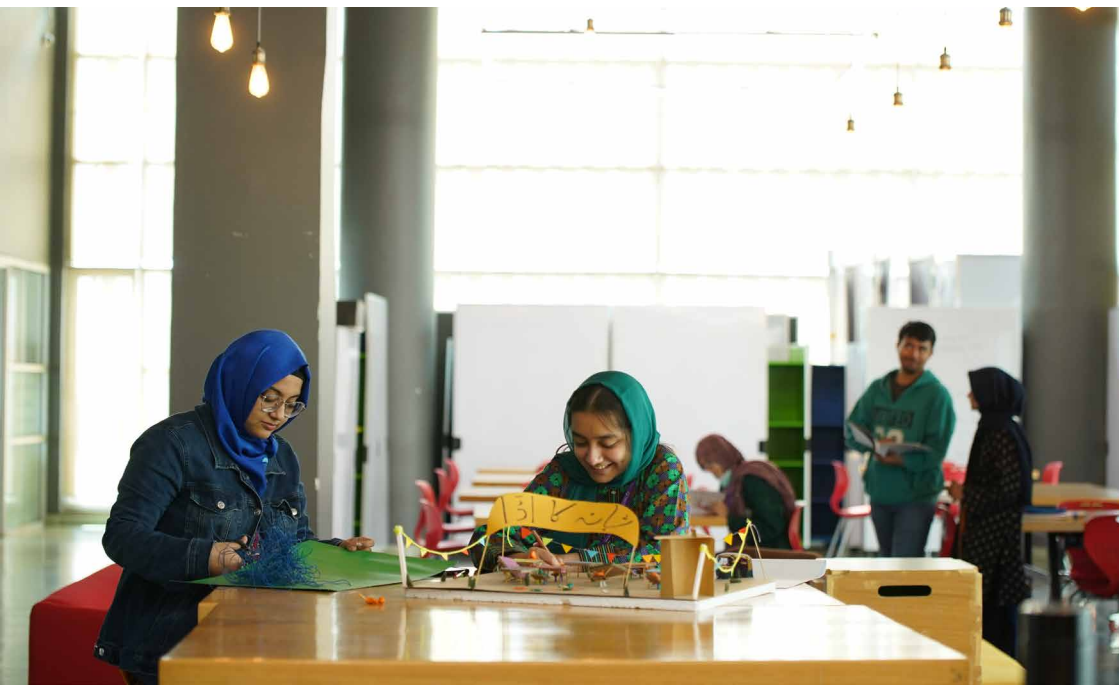

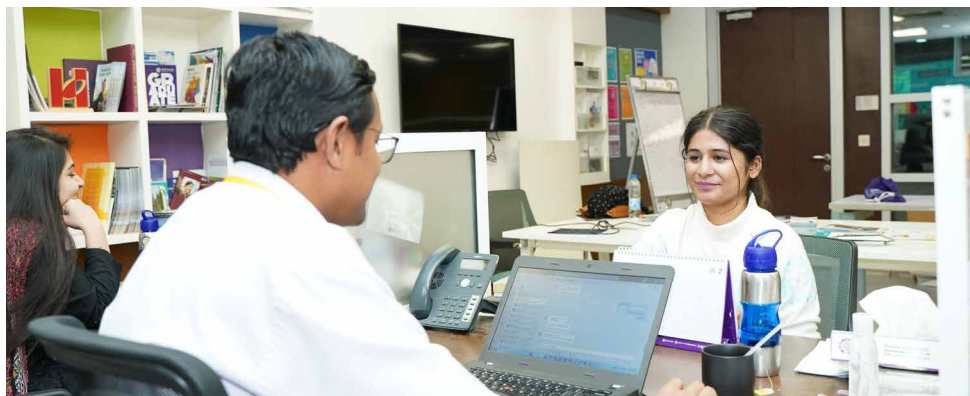
